The Editorial Board of Białostockie Studia Prawnicze invites submissions for the issue titled: *Enhancing International Law – Needs and Proposals*.

In recent decades, international law has confronted unprecedented challenges that test its efficacy and distinctive adaptive capacity. Critics increasingly question its relevance with growing boldness. Globalisation, technological advancements, geopolitical shifts, and unpredictable crises - such as pandemics, climate change, cyber threats, or armed conflicts - not only exposed gaps in existing legal frameworks but also revealed profound impotence in the face of violators.

Scholarly discourse in this context cannot, by necessity, be confined to specific domains but must remain open to both reconstructive deliberations and systematising approaches. International legal scholarship must counter aggressive disinformation with its core strengths: substantive and interdisciplinary expertise, cogent argumentation, and bold yet substantiated intellectual projections. We invite proposals for articles that identify and diagnose challenges

facing contemporary international law while proposing pertinent solutions. We anticipate doctrinal, institutional, and procedural analyses.

Given the 2027 publication schedule, we encourage contributions addressing both enduring issues and entirely novel challenges that may emerge by the submission deadline. We aim to stimulate debate on the foundational tenets of theory and practical concerns, oriented towards bolstering the resilience of international law in a multipolar world.
